Ovarian Cancer Screening Appointments: October 16, November 6, 10:00 a.m. (We will be leaving the Extension Office at 8:30 a.m.)

If you didn't know, the University of Kentucky Markey Cancer Center has a FREE Ovarian Cancer Screening Research program. To be eligible for the free screening, you must have one or both ovaries and be over the age of 50 (or over the age of 25 if you have a documented family history of ovarian cancer). The UK screening program is always free and open to anyone who meets the eligibility requirements.

The opportunity to ride together in the Extension van is only open to homemaker members. Space is limited.
