AGEEMENT BETWEEN TEEN COUNSELOR/CIT & SHELBY COUNTY 4-H

This contract contains the responsibilities and duties of the camp counselor while at 4-H camp. By signing the contract, the counselors agree to accept and carry out these responsibilities.

CAMP COUNSELOR GENERAL RESPONSIBILITY

Assume responsibility for a group of campers for 24 hours a day during camp.

SPECIFIC DUTIES

- · Counselor Job Description, Code of Conduct, and Counselor training material apply.
- · Participate in camp counselor training session
- · Know where your campers are at all times (including free time) and be present at critical times.
- · Promote a helping relationship by interacting with your cabin's campers at all times during camp.
- · Be aware of health, safety and well-being of your campers. Check for illness or injury.
- · Report major health problems to camp health professional.
- · See that you, your campers and fellow counselors know and observe camp rules.
- · Help your cabin group follow the daily camp schedule.
- · Be sensitive to camper's personalities, differences and needs.
- · Be aware that your campers will copy your behavior.

Counselor agrees to accept the above responsibilities and support their peers, volunteers and agents while at camp. If a serious infraction occurs, Teen Counselors may be dismissed from camp. It is the parent's responsibility to pick up any counselor that is dismissed for disciplinary reasons.
